Clubs, State and National teams need and welcome medical personnel-doctors, physiotherapists, masseurs, to travel with the team or be available at competitions.

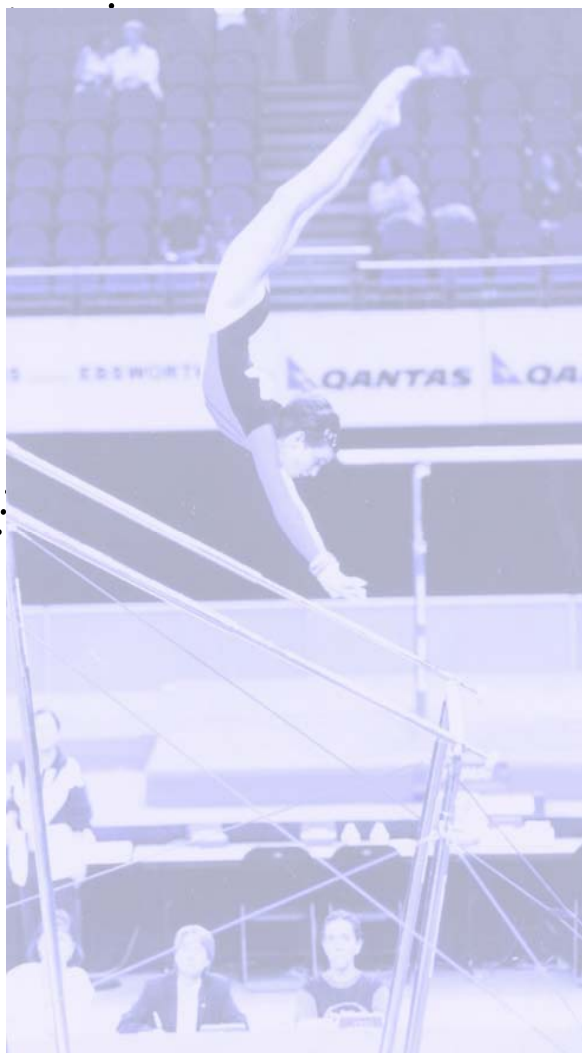
Event Officials

Gymnastics for Everybody

Of all the sports, gymnastics and gym sports require one of the highest number of officials! The ratio of official to gymnast can be very high.

On the coaching side this ratio varies from 1:8 for the early levels to as high as 1:3 for higher level competitors.

At State and National competitions, the ratio of judges to competitors can be as high as 1:1. Other personnel include floor managers, score table, equipment handlers, music controller, announcer, first aid, security and medal bearers.

A well supported event, at any level, showcases unity within the sport, as well as a respect for the athletes' commitment.

Furthermore, such events present gymnastics positively to the general sports community.

Judging Opportunities

Gymnastics judging is not only essential but both enjoyable and rewarding, allowing participants to become part of a highly competent and respected team.

Gymnastics ACT and Canberra City have several nationally accredited judges and course presenters. Nationally accredited courses and Club updating workshops are held regularly. Courses are progressive and are designed to introduce people to the basics of gymnastics judging and then build on that knowledge through further courses, workshops and competition experience.

Participation can eventually lead to travel to State or National competitions as a Club or ACT representative.

Typically, judges are former gymnasts, coaches, parents, teachers.

Coaching Opportunities

Gymnastics coaching is a rewarding career where you have the opportunity to work with children of all abilities and ages. A career in coaching can lead you to become anything from an early childhood development specialist, to an international coach, or a program coordinator.

Gymnastics ACT runs nationally accredited courses. These courses are progressive and are designed to introduce people to the basics of gymnastics coaching and then build on that knowledge through apprenticeships, lectures, practical demonstrations and Club updating workshops. The Australian Coaching Council provides more advanced courses.
