- **All Around** Medals will be presented for 1st, 2nd and 3rd placings.
Certificates will be presented for 4th, 5th and 6th placings.
 - **Apparatus** Medals will be presented for 1st, 2nd and 3rd placings.
Certificates will be presented for 4th, 5th and 6th placings.
 - **Team** Medals will be presented for 1st, 2nd and 3rd placings.
Certificates will be presented for 4th, 5th and 6th placings.

National

Level 4 – 6: 6 gymnasts per team with the top 3 scores to count on each apparatus.

Level 7 – 10: 6 gymnasts per team with the top 3 scores to count on each apparatus.
(level 7 – 10 team may be a combined team of gymnasts from each level)

(Clubs may enter more than one team)

State

Level 5 – 6: 6 gymnasts per team with the top 3 scores to count on each apparatus.

Level 7 – 10: 6 gymnasts per team with the top 3 scores to count on each apparatus.
(level 7 – 10 team may be a combined team of gymnasts from each level)
