GENERAL HOUSEKEEPING: FOR SAFETY AND THE COMFORT OF OTHERS

- All siblings under the age of 2 that are mobile and on the equipment must have their \$44 insurance paid. If a sibling is over the age of 2 and actively participating in the class then full fees must be paid.
- Parents/Care Givers are not allowed to use the gym equipment. This includes the trampoline. If you would like to try gymnastics there is an adult's class on Thursday nights 8pm till 9:30pm. All Levels are welcome.
- No food or drinks on the floor.
- Children with long hair must have all their hair tied back, (this includes boys.)
- **Mobile Phones must NOT be used during class times unless for emergencies.** We had many children accessing equipment while their supervising adults were occupied on the phone. This puts your child and other children's safety at risk.
- If your child is sick they are entitled to have a make-up lesson within the current term. As a courtesy to your coaches and others, please do not bring sick children to the gym. Sick school age children must also not be on the floor, they can sit up on the viewing platform.
