Singapore Open Final Bulletin

Dear Parents and Gymnasts,

For your information – here are the arrangements for the Singapore Open:

Bus to/from Sydney Domestic T3: Greyhound service departing **6:30am, 24th September, Jolimont Centre**. For those departing Singapore 1st October, Greyhound will pick us up at Sydney Domestic T3 at 1:50pm arriving **5:00pm 2nd October, Jolimont Centre**. Cost is **\$37** each way. Please note the following (gymnasts please bring your student id card)

1. Check-in 20 minutes prior to departure
2. Maintain all luggage under 20 kilograms. 2 pieces of luggage per person
3. Photo identification in the form of drivers license or passport and /or concession card will be required

While on the bus to Sydney, adults can arrange to look after gymnasts' valuables if necessary. Please note: Mary has parents' mobile numbers.
