NSW MG Grand Prix Round 2 2010 Hunter Invitational

Dear Parents and Gymnasts,

You may be aware that the Sydney Invitational (at Northern Beaches) has been cancelled. There are four NSW Grand Prix events scheduled by NSW Gymnastics. Canberra City's Squad 1 is participating in the event on the weekend of 26th & 27th June – being the best timing in the lead up for the GACT competitions. Coach Dmitry would like to enter the Level 4 boys in the L4 U/10 competition and the Level 6 boys in the L6 Open competition. Event information is attached.

Gymnasts may be in a session on Saturday afternoon (the timetable will be available on the 9th June after entries have closed) so the group will be travelling up to Glendale early on the Saturday morning. The Club has tentatively hired a 14-seater bus, which Brian Hewett has kindly offered to drive. However, if a competitor's parent has a licence to drive a 14-seater and would like to volunteer – they would be most welcome. The trip takes around 5 to 5 1/2 hours.

Travelling will be the eight gymnasts, coach(es), driver and a couple of chaperones. Accommodation for Saturday night has been organised at Macquarie Inn at Club Macquarie, which is close to the competition venue - Hunter Sports Centre - and shopping centres.
