3. President's Report

The Club has enjoyed a busy year in all aspects of its operations with the Committee firmly focusing on increasing participation and enjoyment in the sport of gymnastics, while continuing to improve the conditions of 'work' and the physical environment for our athletes, staff and volunteers.

Although we did not have to deal with a catastrophic event, such as last year's office fire, we have faced a break-in and burglary (January), thefts from the Club's foyer, graffiti and vandalism. The advent of pay-parking along Chandler street in February placed increased pressure on the Club's carpark. Infringement-type notices and the poor condition of the carpark have just about dissuaded non-member parking.

The Club continues to participate in Community events such as Westfields Christmas Parade and the Watson 40th Birthday celebrations, both last November and various school fetes. A small display group took 'gymnastics' to Aranda preschool and Ainslie primary during the Olympics and a display is being organized for the Miles Franklin fete due to be held in three weeks time. These events are especially enjoyable for the gymnasts while increasing the profile of gym sports within the local community. Of course, our in-house competition/display, the Christmas Cup, aims to bring extended families and the community into the gym and continues to be an enjoyable day with 'all-hands-on-deck'!

Gymnastic Results

Again, Club gymnasts have enjoyed excellent outcomes in both ACT, interstate and National competitions. All event results are attached.

The Club entered full contingents to all the ACT Levels Program (ALP) competitions held in the ACT and was again a strong presence both in numbers and results with MAG and WAG gymnasts achieving coveted Gold and Blue ribbons. In the ALP level 5 to level 10, our gymnasts regularly featured in the top three, and expectations are high that performances will be similar at the ACT grading next weekend. Travel continues to be an exciting dimension for ALP gymnasts after last year's inaugural success. Boys have participated in the Boorowa Invitational as well as the NSW Country Championships and a contingent of MAG & WAG will contest the Snowy Mountains Invitational this weekend.

Events over the last twelve months included Reach for the Stars last December. Anthea Hewett was an Australia B team member contesting the International Levels Challenge against South Africa and New Zealand, coming 6th overall and later winning the beam competition.

This year was certainly a year of travel with senior gymnasts attending NSW Championships Trials in February, the Suncorp Games, Cairns, in April, as well as Australian Championships in Sydney in May.

All our National Womens Artistic Gymnasts (WAG) performed very well at State Championships with juniors winning the Champion Club trophy at level 1. Canberra City went on to win the level 4 to 6 Champion Club trophy with Katrina Le and Bethany Philp being ACT level 4 & level 6 Champions respectively. In levels 7 to 10, Phillipa Dickens, Lauren Donne and Anthea Hewett became the level 7, 9 and 10 State Champions respectively with Anthea Hewett named ACT Gymnast of the Year (2003-2004), an honour received by a Canberra City Club gymnast for many years.

All trialling CCGC gymnasts represented the ACT at Australian Championships and *all* qualified for 'finals' with several top 4 results achieved after the two days of competitions. Notable was Elise Wright's Gold medal on level 7 uneven bars, Anthea Hewett's selection to the Australia A team and Phillipa Dickens' selection to the Australia B team for July's Levels International Challenge.

A squad of level 4 to 10 Canberra City gymnasts qualified to compete at the Junior and Senior Women's National Clubs, held at the AIS Arena in July this year. Canberra City's level 4 team won Bronze on Bars, while our level 6 team, Melissa Orr, Bethany Philp and Sarah Wright, won Gold on both Bars and Beam, an outstanding achievement for a small team. Following on, both Anthea Hewett (L10) and Phillipa Dickens (L7) won Silver medals in the Levels International Challenge against strong opponents Japan and New Zealand.

The Club's most recent travel was to China, involving 13 level 5 to level 10 gymnasts plus coaches and chaperones. All have agreed that the trip was an unforgettable social and cultural experience. Gymnasts performed upgraded routines more than satisfactorily in preparation for competition at the next level when back in Australia. It was a final performance for long-serving Canberra City and ACT gymnast, Anthea Hewett!

Heartfelt thanks must go to the coaches and chaperones for making the visit such a great success.

Staff

Sadly, we farewelled Ludmila Kostenko in April when she left to join family members in Brisbane.

A big welcome to 'new' staff for 2004: Natasha Schumacher, working in an organisational role as well as increasing her coaching duties.

Geoff Monro taking on MAG and schools programs as a permanent staff member.

Rita Wotkina, Ballet coach.

Jakki Woywitka, level 2 coach from Canada, studying coaching science at UC and currently filling in for Ludmila.

Phil Cossens, Physiotherapist. Phil visits the Club every 2 to 3 weeks on a Saturday afternoon to assist in injury recovery and prevention.

The National program and Club ethos continues to be strengthened under Qu Derui's jovial leadership. We are also indeed fortunate to have the ACT senior WAG levels Judge, Connor Carson, continuing to advise the Committee and coaching at the Club.

The Committee has continued its policy to support personal and professional development for all staff by subsidising course fees and travel as well as holding regular in-Club workshops. The continuing challenge for the Committee is to balance the very transient nature of the gymnastics coaching scene with appointments of young professional coaching and administration staff.

Membership & Advertising. Mergers.

Membership numbers have grown to average around 800 (approximately 650 last year) for the whole year including children participating in our Schools program. The enrolment form survey indicates that TV advertising and word-of-mouth are how most members learn of the Club. This year, the Committee has also contributed to published supplements: Our Babies (Canberra Times), Capital Parent and PCYC Australia's Kidsmart publication. Of course, the Olympics always provide some impetus to sporting programs.

Early this year, Canberra City and Northside clubs: TEAM Gymnastics, RAGE Gungahlin, and Miles Franklin Gymnastics, began the transition process of merging to become one club. This was mainly at the request for administrative assistance from the smaller clubs. The process has now been finalised with success, we believe. Canberra City certainly hopes that, as a parent organisation, we can maintain participation levels at the various campuses with the view to increased numbers over time. Many thanks to committee members of the satellite programs – who have worked hard to ensure as smooth a transition as possible.

Schools Program

This area of the Club's operation has been a success story; going from one school in 1999 to 10 schools by 2003. This program is a major contributor, not only to our participation numbers (eventually at the Club), but also to the Club's financial well being. The success of such a program depends greatly on the special expertise and patience required of our coaches working in this area.

Education

The Club continues to hold technical workshops every term. Connor Carson held a very successful level 1 Judges' course in November of last year. This year, we were fortunate to also have both a Physiotherapy and a First-Aid information session at the Club. Thank you to Physio, Phil Cossens and Paramedic, Doug Wright for their time and expertise.

Building, Infrastructure and Equipment.

The Club has been subjected to some major make-over projects this year – its 25th year of existence. You may have noticed (worked hard on) the following:

- The complete refurbishment of the Ballet room, thanks to the fundraising group. Cost ~\$6000.
- The new sprung floor, thanks Brian Hewett for saving the Club around \$12000. Cost ~\$25000.
- The insulation and lining of the interior walls of the gym. Cost ~\$12000.
- A second vaulting table, new vault strip, new beam, extra mats, new springboard.

The Committee is pleased to be able to realise these milestone projects and equipment purchases improving the work and training environment for members.

Office & Administration. Communication.

Office Manager Jenny Xian's administration workload has increased along with the mergers mentioned above and the success of all the Club's programs. The Committee thanks Jenny for her commitment and professionalism, which of course, contribute to the Club's success.

The Committee's streamlining of office operations continues with the current project, due for completion within a couple of weeks: the installation of Transact Broadband and the networking of the office computers.

Canberra City's website has been live since early this year and may be found at:

<http://www.canberracity.org.au/> . Quite a few pages are still under construction, however information, notices, forms, newsletters, policies and useful links are currently available. The aim is to provide electronically the communication of information already in the gym via notice-boards and notices.

The Club submitted to an extremely thorough (5 hours on the day, many hours in the months before) Club 10 quality assurance Audit in September and, happily, maintained its accreditation at the National Standard level. The visit by an external officer was particularly informative and positive.

Volunteer Efforts. Grants. Awards.

Thanks to the volunteer effort of the Club's members, gymnasts, parents, coaches and judges, we again earned future financial support for the Club's contribution to the hosting of the Reach for the Stars competition in December 2003 as well as around \$6000 for the most successful National Clubs WAG L4 to L10 held at the AIS Arena in July 2004. Lesley Dickens' tea & coffee stall at this event was an amazing success, raising over \$1600 for the Club.

The ACT Gymnastics Association received an ACT Event Organisation Award earlier this year, which reflects on the wonderful volunteer efforts of its affiliated clubs.

Closer to home, the Committee wishes to formally thank the volunteer efforts of Jane Donne and Donna Hopkinson, and the mini-band of parents, who have been the backbone of another year of the Saturday morning Sausage Sizzles (~\$4300 to date). I urge all members to support their efforts.

Thanks must also go to Wests Rugby Club, with whom we are affiliated, for supporting the Sausage Sizzles with sausages and bread since March 2003.

The Club's 2004 application for a Wests grant was also successful with \$4000 presented. The Club also has two 2004 grant applications in with ACT Sport and Recreation; mainly to upgrade office computing facilities and to replace the old-technology internal lighting; and one grant application in with the Chief Minister's Department in the 'Renewing Community Facilities' round, to refurbish the change rooms. Announcements are due in November.

Finally, **congratulations** to Brian Hewett, recipient of an ACT Volunteer Award and to Anthea Hewett, recipient of Wests 2004 Senior Sports Star Award. Anthea was nominated by Anthony Donne, the Club's liaison officer. Also to Canberra City itself, which received a congratulatory letter from the Australian Sports Commission citing CCGC graduate, Belinda Archer 2001, and her position on the Olympic 'shadow' team.

Finance

Members may note that much of the discussion above is reflected through account-lines in our Profit and Loss statement.

Fees have been maintained for a couple of years (longer for National competition athletes) and have just been increased by \$5 to \$10 per term/quarter. This decision was made at a Committee budget meeting in July in anticipation of increasing wages and employment on-costs.

On the other side of the ledger.....

Staff Wages (and therefore on-costs such as now-9% superannuation, workers compensation, etc.) increased again in 2004.

Professional Development, mentioned earlier, has been supported by full reimbursement of Senior First Aid course and National Judging course fees following successful completion by staff members.

Maintenance and Equipment Purchases are important ongoing aspects of current and future expense for Club safety and success.

The Committee looks forward to members' input in relation to suggested further improvements for the Club environment.

Referring to the financial statements.....

The Club has posted an operating surplus, which has been maintained and *increased to this date*.

This is a particularly pleasing result considering the major expenses incurred this year.

It appears we are in credit with the ATO for over payment of GST (\$2074).

Liabilities as at 30 June 2004 include some leave provisions as well as the usual July wages and on-costs.

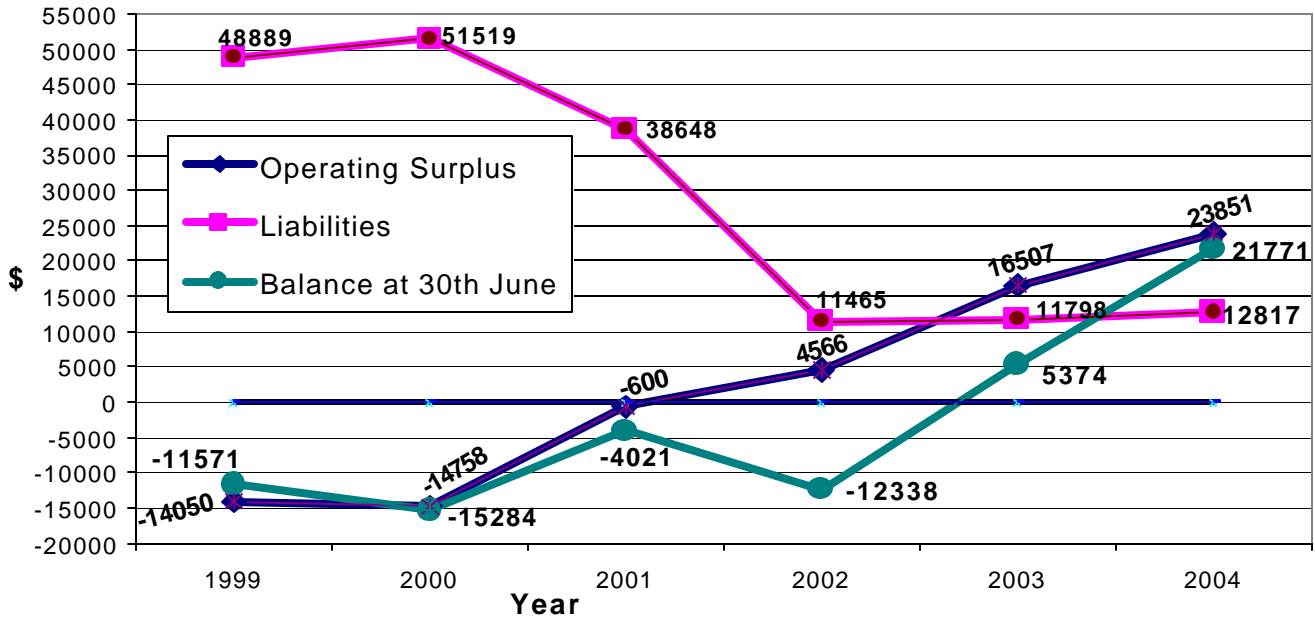
