3. President's Report

2011 began with the Club dealing with a destructive flood in the bar pit. At that time the Committee competed with the many claims bombarding insurance companies. Delivery of wet and sun tanned foam complicated matters. Thanks to the many volunteer hours, the Club was able to operate fully by the start of term 1, although we have only recently received the custom made pit edging!

Term 1 and Term 2 saw continued construction of the over the car park floor space, providing warm-up and warm-down space for development groups as well as a dedicated ballet space. The area has since also been used as spectator space. The new north facing entry, coach communication and resource area and better car park facilities were an added positive outcome. At this time we were faced with ailing drainage pipes under the building, destructive drainage in the car park and surrounding the south and west sides of the building... a decision was made to pursue earthworks around the building, and leveling and patching the car park. The need to further improve the exterior with some basic plantings has been noted.

During the year the Club assisted GACT in hosting Men's National Championships and Women's National Club's Championships both at the AIS Arena.

Club representatives also served on GACT's Board and Men's and Women's Technical Committees.

The Parent Fundraising sub-committee was particularly active this year, organizing an extensive chocolate sales drive and events such as: the Sleepover; Family Portraits; Gold Coast Raffle; Easter Raffle; Halloween Disco; Presentation night.

More details regarding the Club's activities follow.

Gymnastic Events & Results

CCGC has once again enjoyed record participation numbers during GACT's competition season. In particular, 145 gymnasts, including a GymAble student, entered the State Levels 1 to 4 Grading day!

A number of CCGC gymnasts became Apparatus and/or All Around Champions in the Levels 4 to 10 competitions and two gymnasts qualified to represent the ACT at Men's Nationals – a first for the Club. New Club member, Philippe Rizzo, mentored by coach Dmitry Berezovski qualified to the World Championships squad. Unfortunately, injury curtailed Phil's continuation to the final trials.

Our representatives to Women's Australian Championships performed very well, one returning with a bronze medal and another gaining selection to the Australian Team that competed in the South Africa Games' gymnastics event.

Also very successful were the Women's Level 6 and Level 7 gymnasts competing for the ACT at Border Challenge and for the Club at National Club's Championships.

Events hosted at the Club received very positive feedback regarding our hospitality and our very own Christmas Cup 2010 was very successful.

During the next week the Club will again be running the Kindergym Challenge daily and will finish the year with Christmas Cup 2011!

More detailed results may be found at the end of this report.

Staff & Education

The Club welcomed Olga Yermakova as a senior coach to the Men's program; Olga has also started a small Zumba program at the Club!

It is fortunate that several coaches had been mentored by Morgan and have been able to continue the GymABLE program following her departure to study in Perth.

The Club values education highly and subsidises workshops and other updating opportunities.

In February this year 28 staff gained their Senior First Aid accreditation at a course run at the Club.

Participation Membership & Growth

Membership numbers for 2011 reached **1030**, a small increase on last year's final figure and our highest yet. We may attribute this to the professional coaching, supervising and office staff at the Club. ***MG, WG, State & National and Recreation*** programs are showing enthusiastic participation and good retention rates.

The Club hopes to capitalise on the anticipated exposure of gymnastics during the 2012 Olympic Year!

Schools / External Programs

Programs continue at Lyneham and Macquarie Primary School showing maximum participation.

The Club's two day program in Gungahlin, run at Amaroo School, has been particularly successful this year (approximately 35 gymnasts each afternoon) and coaches will trial a further expansion in 2012.

Also being considered is a fledgling program at Queanbeyan West High School. There is no gym program currently available for youngsters in Queanbeyan.

Once again, the Club provided an in-school 5 weeks program to Gundaroo PS early in Term 4.

The Club continues to provide and maintain suitable equipment for these programs.

Schools gymnasts are encouraged to participate in the ACT Levels 1-4 Grading competitions and the Club's Christmas Cup.

Community

The Club continues to fulfil its role as a Community venue. We currently have up to 200 participants using-hiring the facility on some kind of regular basis. Groups are:

Cheerleading; year-round; Sirens;
Snow Sports ACT; 14th March to 27th June – dry-land training
Canberra Diving Academy; Dry-land training;
Circus Space; year round;
University of Canberra School of Teacher Education; semester two – August to November
Clear Vision Films Stunt Training; year-round;
ACT Hockey; special training;
Primary School training – Good Shepherd (Gungahlin);
Our Holiday Program, which is open to the community.

The Club contributes voucher prizes and, occasionally equipment, to school fetes and trivia events. We also assist schools with some equipment repair and recycling.

All such community assistance by our volunteers is warmly received and is a measure of the Club's Community spirit.

Building, Infrastructure, Equipment, Image

Following the completion of the Stage 7 extension, the Club has finished some minor works such as the west fire door repairs; leg lift rack installation; main floor repair and replacement of damaged floor cover;

The Committee has considered some modification of the pit room pits to incorporate Men's equipment. The new Committee will, discuss this further with all coaches.

Further minor works have been identified; however, the main focus in the near future will be the maintenance and repair of our facility. The concept of tax-deductible contributions to a building fund has come up in auditor report/discussions.

Office, Administration & Communication

A full year of entering each member's fee transactions on MYOB has made the Club's operations transparent to our accountants. Indeed, the audit process has been more confident. Office staff continue to do this work efficiently and professionally.

CCGC Facebook began this year as a way of communicating with coaches and 'friends' regarding the Club's events and achievements. We are yet to assess the value of this initiative and welcome any feedback.

A great deal of effort was put towards submitting the insurance claim and a further grant application for car park repairs and earthworks.

The Committee also focussed on updating some policies in the course of our meetings. Although electronically available, hard copies of all these are planned for the New Year.

Sponsorship

The Club is no longer ‘sponsored’ by the Canberra Southern Cross Club. It has become increasingly difficult for us to participate in the volunteer roster to run CSCC raffles and we have not found other opportunities to make ourselves eligible for the very small amount of financial support.

The Club does receive small grants from GACT for our help in organizing and/or running national events in Canberra, such as Men’s Nationals and Women’s National Clubs Championships. This year we received \$1650 for Men’s Nationals, which we have put towards a new Rings’ set. The National Clubs amount may reach \$3500 plus a small amount for hosting around 250 gymnasts’ training during the event.

Financials

At all times, the management pursues avenues to maintain service at reasonable cost and to achieve a ‘not-for-profit’ result.

We have re-negotiated our Workers’ Compensation premiums at 2.9% (were 3.75%) of wages.

Our persistence in repaying our loan reduced the balance to \$197,000 by April 2011, allowing the Club to re-draw \$90,000 as part of our contribution to the Stage 7 Extension costs offset by the Capital Assistance grant (\$116,000 net of GST) received from the ACT government. The \$277,000 balance in April is now reduced to \$239,000 and we are on track to amortize the loan at the end of 2016 if not before.

A small fee increase (\$0.50 or less per hour) was approved for 2012. We believe that we continue to provide services at a competitively high standard at reasonable fees.

The extraordinary amount of refurbishment, fit-out and infrastructure repairs, on top of the extension costs, have stretched the Club’s finances.

Auditor & Accounting

Christine Reid & Associates have provided accounting services and prepared the end-of-year financial statements for presentation to the company auditor, Matthew Walker of Ledger & Walker.

Referring to the financial statements.....

The large operating profit has been an unusual result, however is explained by the inclusion of both the Capital Assistance grant (\$116,000) and the insurance payout (\$31,000). You may also recall that the change to pure accrual accounting last audit meant that fees prepaid for Term 3 2010 could not be included, resulting in an operating loss, on paper, for 2010.

In reality the Committee has taken all opportunities this year to re-invest in Club infrastructure and resources for *all* current members' and participants' benefit.

In conclusion.....

The above report to members provides a snapshot of Club decisions, events, contributions and outcomes.

I would like to thank the outgoing Committee Members for all their hard work and enthusiasm.

Ongoing for the new committee will be the review and renewal of procedures and policies as well as the ongoing maintenance of the facility's equipment, infrastructure and surrounds. I hope that further use of a sub-committee structure will help to spread the volunteer load.

From a personal perspective and believing in gymnastics as a fundamental movement for youngsters, I can highly recommend the very rewarding nature of contributing to the Club's development. I therefore encourage members to participate whenever and wherever possible!

The Club looks forward to your continued support and contribution.

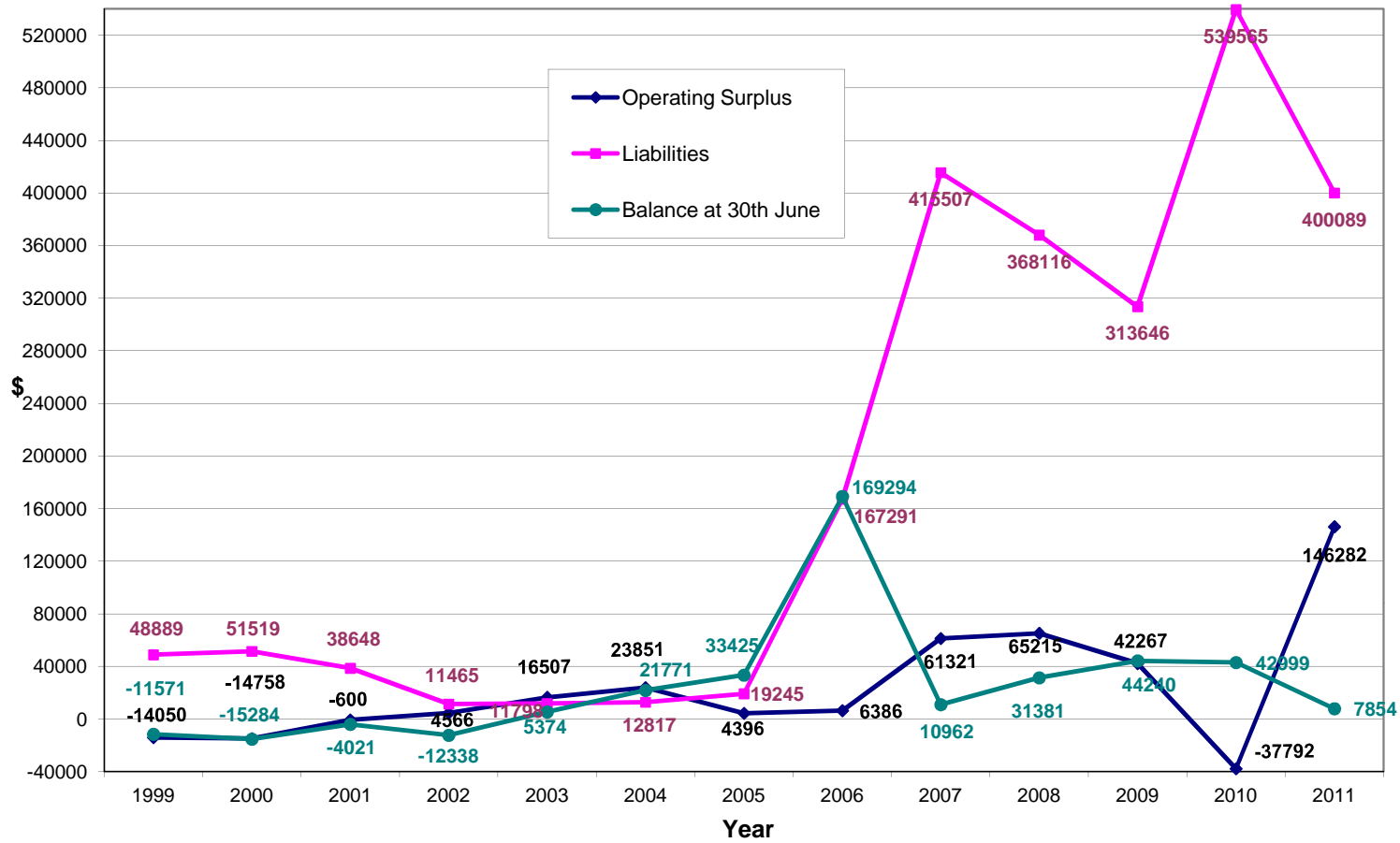

Report on the Financial Report

In our opinion, except for the possible effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph, we report that the financial report of the Canberra City Gymnastic Club Incorporated is properly drawn up:

- so far as to give a true and fair view of matters required by subsection 72(2) of the Associations Incorporation Act 1991 to be dealt with in the financial report for the year ended 30th June 2011, in accordance with the accounting policies described in Note 1
- in accordance with the provisions of the Associations Incorporation Act 1991, and
- complying with Australian Accounting Standards to the extent described in Note 1

We report that:

- The audit was conducted in accordance with the rules of the association
- We are satisfied that proper accounting records and other records have been kept by the association as required by the Associations Incorporation Act 1991.

Basis of Accounting

Without modifying our opinion, we draw attention to note 1 to the financial report, which describes the basis of accounting.

The special purpose financial report has been prepared for distribution to members for the purpose of fulfilling the committee's financial reporting requirements under the Associations Incorporation Act (ACT).

As a result, the financial report may not be suitable for any other purpose.
